MR Credit: Interiors Life-Cycle Impact Reduction The flexibility, modularity, and quality of products allow reuse and will adapt to new needs, contributing to this point for future projects.	1-4 points
MR Credit: Building Product Disclosure and Optimization All metal storage furniture is made out of cold-rolled steel. 27.3% post-consumer recycled content and 40.6% post-industrial recycled content.	1 point
MR Credit: Construction and Demolition Waste Management The packaging of furniture is primarily made of easy to recycle materials (corrugated cardboard, polyethylene film, honeycomb cartons, wood frames).	1-2 points
INDOOR ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY (EQ)	
EQ Credit: Low-Emitting Materials GREENGUARD GOLD Certification for low emissions. Low-emitting products reduce emission during construction and flush-out.	1-3 points
